Overview

Daniel S. Cooper (Harvard A.B. '95, UC Riverside M.Sc. '99) is a consulting biologist and the author of <u>Important Bird Areas of California</u> (Audubon California 2004). He is recognized as an authority on California bird ecology, identification and distribution, and has a strong background in many aspects of southern California natural history, including plants, herptiles, and mammals. His geographic areas of expertise include the Ballona Wetlands, Santa Monica Mountains, Santa Clara River, Puente-Chino Hills, Palos Verdes peninsula, and remnant habitat patches across the floor of the Los Angeles Basin. Mr. Cooper has designed and managed numerous monitoring projects and assessments for a wide variety of clients, including public agencies and municipalities, large consulting firms, private landowners, and nonprofit organizations. He has also developed and taught courses on local ecology through Loyola Marymount University and UCLA Extension School, conducted fieldwork overseas, and led field trips and nature tours for nearly 30 years.

Mr. Cooper is permitted by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and California Department of Fish and Wildlife to perform protocol surveys for California gnatcatcher since 2005, and later added yellow-billed cuckoo, southwestern willow flycatcher and San Diego cactus wren to his permits. He has more than 20 years of professional experience surveying for and observing special-status species throughout California. Cooper has held a Master Station Bird Banding permit from the U.S. Geological Survey, and holds a scientific collecting permit from the California Dept. of Fish and Game.
